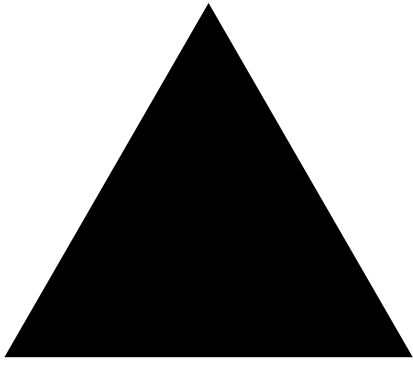
## Noun Family Three Part Cards

### **Level 10.1**

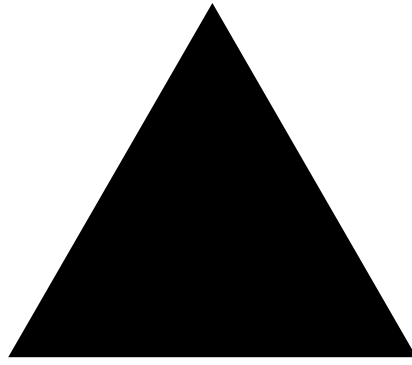
This set includes 3 part cards (picture with label, label, picture) of each Noun along with its definition card.

2. Cut the cards along the border and ask the child to match the label with the correct symbol.



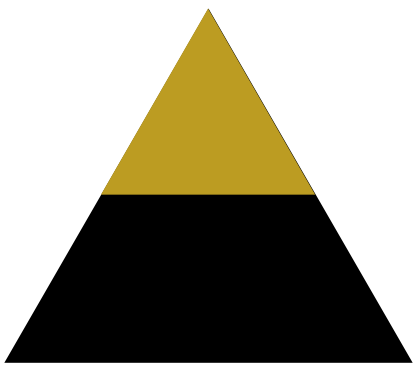
Common Noun



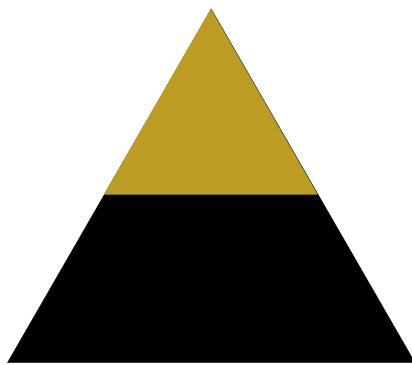
Common Noun

For example book, girl, country, etc



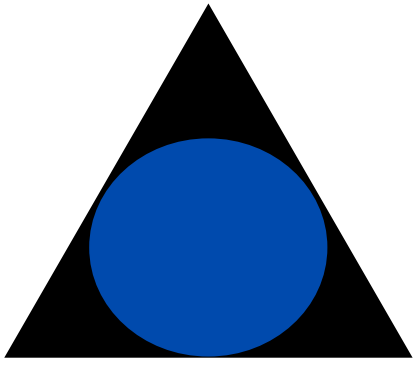
Proper Noun



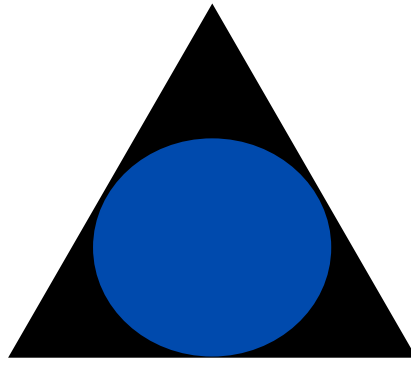
Proper Noun

For example Kevin, England, Texas, Sara, etc.



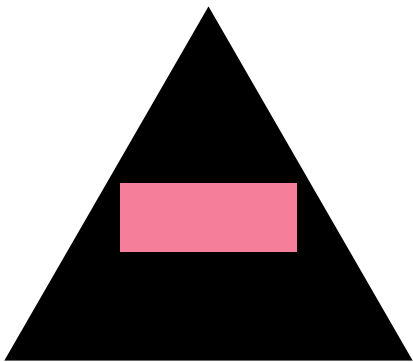
Abstract Noun



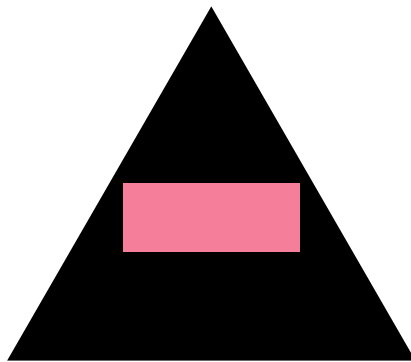
Abstract Noun

Abstract Nouns are the nouns that express ideas, concepts, or qualities that cannot be seen or experienced.

For example: freedom, love, democracy, etc.

The Collective noun is a word that denotes a group of people or things.
