



Sentence Analysis

Level 2: Identify the subject, predicates and direct objects in the sentences.

Subject: is what or whom the sentence is about

Predicate: is the part of the sentence that tells something about the subject.

Direct Object: is the receiver of the action within a sentence, and it is usually a noun or pronoun. It is used with action verbs.

For example, In sentence,

Sam played the guitar.

Subject

Sam

to whom..
to what..

Predicate

played

**Direct
Object**

the guitar

whom?
what?
