



Sentence Analysis

Level 3: Identify the subject, predicates, direct and indirect objects in the sentences.

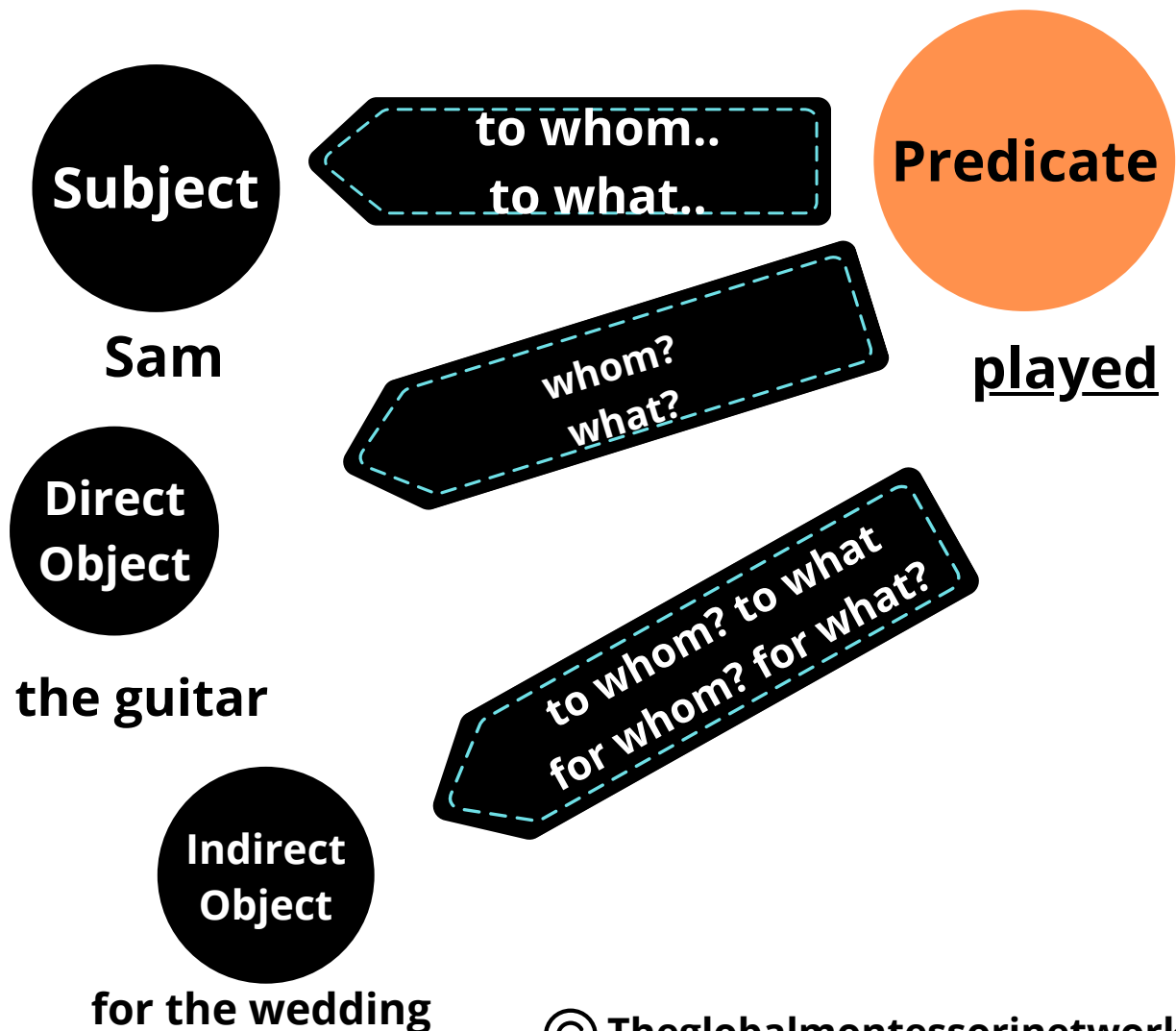

Direct Object: is the receiver of the action within a sentence, and it is usually a noun or pronoun.

Indirect object: identifies “to whom, to what, for whom, for what” the verb’s action is performed. It can only be in a sentence if there is also a direct object.

For example, In sentence,

Sam played the guitar for the wedding.
