

## **Sentence Analysis**




**Subject:** is what or whom the sentence is about **Predicate:** is the part of the sentence that tells something about the subject.

**Adverbial phrase**: is a group of words that refines the meaning of a verb, adjective, or adverb.

For example, In sentence,

Sara sings loudly.
