

Prefix 'Re' and 'Un'

<u>Use of re-/un- prefixes before the words</u> <u>to form new words</u>

Rules of using the above prefixes:

- Re- prefix means again, back or it indicates repetition.
- Use un- prefix before words that start with a vowel or consonant. It means opposite.
