


Magic 'e' or Silent 'e'

Exploring the silent letter 'e' at the end of the word



Silent e rule: When we add an 'e' to the end of words with a short vowel sound, it changes the sound and meaning. It makes the vowel sound long and says its alphabet name whereas the 'e' becomes silent.
