


## **Consonant Blend: CH**

Exploring the words starting with consonant blend/ digraph ch

When 2 or more consonants blend together then it is called a Consonant Blend. In such a blend each consonant's sound is heard. Common consonant blends are cl, bl, fl, br, cr, dr, and ch.
